

DRAWING THE MAP

1. Take a sheet of blank, unlined paper and draw a line from the top down through the center of the page. Mark the top of the line NORTH. Mark the bottom of the line SOUTH.
2. Draw a line from the right side to the left side through the middle of the page. Mark the left side of the line WEST. Mark the right side of the line EAST.
3. Put a dot on the NORTH-SOUTH line. This will be the starting point.
4. Use a protractor to determine the angles of the lines using the bearings taken from the compass.
5. Use a ruler to draw the lines, once the correct angle is determined. The scale on the chart will determine how long the line is drawn.

*** Maps will rarely come together perfectly. There will be a gap from the finish to the start. You must determine what is an acceptable margin of error.

*** The shape of the course will determine which way students position their paper and the start points.
