

Slow Motion Replay Questions

Where were you when you hit this home run?

Show me how you were standing. Let's see, would you say that your feet are about one foot apart?

Where was the pitcher? Was your body facing the pitcher? No? Then where were you facing?

Which way were you looking?

Where was your bat? Down by your side? No? Then where?

Show me how were you holding the bat! Can you tell me in words how you held the bat? (If the student has trouble, help him/her use words. For example, "Oh, I see you drew the bat back over your right shoulder. Let's see, it's not resting on your shoulder, though. You have it raised above your shoulder about four inches.")

Did you watch the pitcher throw the ball to you? When you saw the ball leave the pitcher's hand, what did you do? (The student may bend his knees, raise his bat, etc. The teacher calls attention to these details.) Did your hands tighten on the bat? Did you choke up on the bat? Did you lean forward?

As you watched the ball coming toward you, what were you thinking? How were you feeling?

When you swung the bat, what happened? Oh, the first ball was a strike? What about the second one? Also a strike?

When the third ball left the pitcher's hand, how did you feel?

When you swung, what happened? Any sounds?

What did you do when your bat hit the ball? Did you look at where the ball was going?

When did you realize that you had hit a home run?

How did the other people at the game react?

Do you still remember the feeling you had as you trotted across home plate?
