<b>Collaboration with peers</b>	Almost always listens to, shares with, and supports the efforts of others in the group. Tries to keep people working well together. <b>Speaks clearly</b>	Speaks clearly and distinctly all the time (100-95%), and mispronounces no words.	Speaks clearly and distinctly all the time (100-95%), but mispronounces one word.
