

Investigating an NC Superfund Site of Interest

Locate a Superfund site in your community or one of interest by visiting EPA's list of *Superfund Sites* at <http://www.epa.gov/region4/waste/npl/index.htm#NC>

Once you have identified a site of interest, click on the name of the site to review a summary of the site along with information about cleanup progress. Using this site summary along with other information available through EPA's Superfund site, answer the following questions:

1. State the name and location of the site. Why did you choose this site?
2. Read the *Site Background* and identify the source of the pollution.
3. List the predominant threats and contaminants of concern at the site.
4. Is soil, ground and/or surface water contaminated at the site? Please describe.
5. Review the *Site Cleanup Plan* and *Cleanup Progress* sections and describe where the site is at in the clean up process.
6. When was the site added to the NPL? If construction (cleanup) has been completed, when was it completed?
7. How can communities be involved in the cleanup of NPL sites?
8. When is an NPL site deleted from the list?
9. State one thing you learned about Superfund and/or the cleanup process as a result of this assignment.
